Description

If you want to work as a nursing clinical instructor and remain in your current role as a practicing nurse – this program is for you!

The NC AHEC Nursing Clinical Partnership Project aims to increase nursing faculty through partnerships between academic nursing programs and practice organizations. NC AHEC, NC academic nursing programs, and practice organizations partnered to launch the CIP Program. This innovative clinical education model prepares qualified RNs to serve as clinical nursing instructors without leaving their clinical role in their practice organization.

Program Details

- Approved by the NC Board of Nursing to meet the 45-hour teaching and learning requirement for new faculty.
- ◆ Taught through online modules, live webinars, and a shadowing experience in a cohort of your peers.

Target Audience

- RNs with a BSN or higher and 2 years of practice experience
- Clinical Instructor Partners (CIP): RNs working in a dual role as clinicians and clinical instructors in the facility where they practice. The academic/practice partners share the costs of employing the CIP.
- For a limited time, Clinical Instructors (CI): RNs working for an academic nursing program teaching clinical to student groups.

What you will gain

- Essential knowledge and skills to be a clinical instructor.
- A support network of nurse educators and other CIPs and CIs.
- Growth and development while enhancing the nursing workforce.
